THIS THREE-LEVEL CERTIFICATE PROGRAM PROVIDES A COMPREHENSIVE FRAMEWORK FOR INTEGRATING CATHOLIC TEACHING INTO CLINICAL PRACTICE.

- Level One establishes foundational concepts and explores topics such as the theology of the human person, the inherent dignity and nature of humanity from a Catholic perspective, and the use of cultural and spiritual tools in clinical work. Additional areas include the interplay between trauma, spirituality, addiction, canon law, and the wisdom of philosophy, theology, and psychology.
- Level Two builds upon this foundation with modules on Catholic Anthropology, Catholic Moral Theology, and Spiritual Theology. In each module, a theologian will present key principles, followed by a psychotherapist who will demonstrate how these concepts apply to clinical case conceptualization and practice.
- **Level Three** offers an advanced exploration of integrating Catholic principles into specialized topics within psychotherapy, equipping clinicians to apply these insights in a range of clinical contexts.

CCPI Levels consist of sequential modules, each delivered live and then made available in our on-demand library prior to the next session. Upon completion of each level, participants will receive a certificate of completion, culminating in a full certificate after all three Levels are completed.
